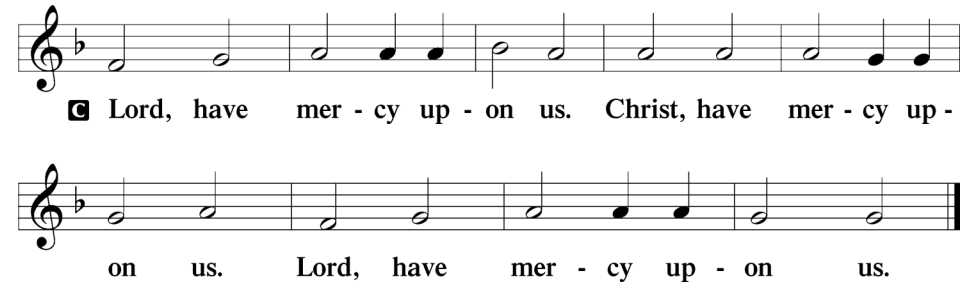

PROVERBS (SPRÜCHE) 4:10-23

In those days, Solomon, son of David, said,

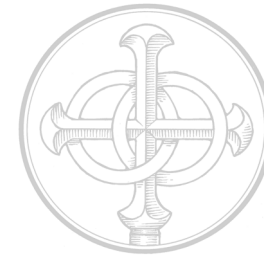
